Dear Colleagues,

Yuriy Fedkovych Chernivtsi National University will host the XX International Conference on Literary Studies on September 25-26, 2025. The Conference will be dedicated to the 80th anniversary of the Department of World Literature and Theory of Literature, as well as to the 150th anniversary of Yuriy Fedkovych Chernivtsi National University.

Literature and Multicultural Experience: Spaces of Dialogue

In terms of globalization processes that promote the active crossing of cultural, linguistic, and national boundaries, there arises a need for new analytical approaches to understanding literature as a dynamic space of intercultural communication, transnational exchange and interaction, the space that both reflects and shapes contemporary hybrid identities¹. Given the growing significance of transcultural and transnational vectors in the humanities², it is important to rethink the role of literature in constructing a space for dialogue between cultures, traditions, and ideologies³. Particular emphasis should be laid on literary narratives that serve as the representations of the "Other", as well as on the functional mechanisms through which literary texts contribute to the development of multicultural consciousness and a tolerant worldview. The Conference will offer a platform to discuss literature as a multicultural space of dialogue along the following thematic areas:

1. Literary Narratives of the Multicultural Space (literary representation of the "Other"; mythopoetics and local identities; multicultural (multinational) literature of Bukovyna).

2. Transculturality and Transnationality in Literature (writers in exile and the diaspora; cultural mobility and hybrid identities; translation as a form multicultural dialogue).

3. Intercultural Poetics and Comparative Literary Studies (dialogue of cultures in literary texts; typological parallels in world literatures; intertextuality as a form intercultural interaction).

4. Literary Studies and Tolerance: the Ethics of Reading (inclusivity in the literary canon; gender, ethnic, and religious representation; postcolonial and decolonial studies).

5. Generative Artificial Intelligence as the "Other" in the Course of Creating, Reading, and Interpreting Literary Texts (the ethics of human – machine interaction in literary discourse; artificial intelligence as a new literary interpreter and mediator).
